Henry John Neudorf

I, Henry John Neudorf, was born August 20, 1902 in the village of Osterwick (Pawlowka). My parents were Johann Johann Neudorf and Helena nee Koslowsky.

Osterwick was in the district of Chortitza, near Alexandrowsk (Zaporoshje), not far from the well-known Dnjepr River. Osterwick was established in 1812; its population in 1814 had reached 167 persons. The village site was situated on the west end of the village Kronstal, which was established in 1909. Osterwick was established the same year when Napoleon marched with his army to Moscow, and by the time Napoleon was retreating from Russia in that extreme cold winter, our villagers were sitting in their warm dwellings unconcerned.

In the Crimean War of 1854-1855 the villagers were involved in that they were required to provide transport for army and supplies.

The effects of the Russo-Japanese war were more extensive than the Crimean War. The outbreak of the revolution immediately following the Russo-Japanese War was repressed very quickly with very little damage incurred to the village. However, the villagers experienced fire damage at various times. The most notable and also the one causing the most loss was the great fire of August 8, 1863. The fire razed 62 dwellings. The fire started when oil overheated on the kitchen stove in the house of Trau Teichroeb. Fortunately there was no loss of life in this catastrophe.

With the construction of two farm implement factories, namely "Schulzen Factory" in 1884, and "Rempels Factory" in 1885, and a flour mill (steam operated) in 1894, Osterwick became one of the leading communities in the colony. Other enterprises included a grist mill, three windmills (for milling flour and chop), brick works, a co-operative store and other shops, such as blacksmith, shoemakers, and tailors were also in operation. The shade trees and fruit trees, which the settlers planted, not only provided shelter from the sun and wind, but also made the village a neat and comfortable place to live.

Our village had a few man-made ponds or watering places. They built a dam across the valley in order to hold the water in one place. Osterwick had one pond on the north side of the village, one on the west end of the village, and a third one further west. In these ponds they watered the cattle that were in the pasture. These ponds were large enough to have fish in them. We also used these ponds to swim in the summer and to give the horses a bath. At the end of a week, in the summer, usually Saturday before supper, we took our working horses to one of these ponds, to give them a bath. The horses enjoyed the bath after a week of hard working in the sun and dust.

In the winter, when the water in these ponds was frozen, the young people used to skate on the ice. These ponds were a couple of hundred feet wide and twice as long, so there was enough room to skate on them. There were also other pleasures in the winter. For example, we hitched two of our best horses to a two-seated sleigh and drove along the streets in the village. Sometimes we

would have sleigh races on the streets or in the pasture outside the village.

The village was divided into twenty full farms (Vollwirtschaft) and twenty half farms. All full farms consisted of sixty-five Desjatin (175 acres). In 1912 there were 1,641 inhabitants in Osterwick. Most of the inhabitants were Mennonites, but there were also Russians, Lutherans and Jews in the village.

The church was built on the east end of the village, next to the street that divided the two villages. The first church served the village until August 27, 1872, when a new and larger building had been built and was dedicated by Bishop Gerhard Wyck the following Sunday September 3, 1872. This building remained until 1937 at which time it was demolished by the Soviet authorities.

The villagers from Kronstal and Schoeneberg also belonged to this parish, who attended the services in the Osterwick church. The Bishops during our time (1900-1924) were Bishop Isaak Dyck and Bishop Peter Neufeld, both being residents of Rosental. The resident Pastors were Rev. David H. Rempel, Rev. Peter Koop, and Rev. Wilhelm Janzen. After the mass emigration to Canada following World War I and the revolution, Jakob Wiens and Peter Reimer were called to serve the church as ministers.

The location of the first school is not recorded. However, a new school was built and dedicated in the fall of 1862. The roof of this school was destroyed by the great fire of 1863. An additional building was added and was dedicated on September 19, 1904. The teachers in the elementary school were:

A new high school (Zentralschule) to serve the community was built and dedicated on October 14, 1921. This project was the monument of Osterwick's Centennial year. The teachers in this school were:

My childhood and youth was a happy one. Our parents had eleven children:

In 1904 our parents bought a farm of 65 desjatin land, with a yard and buildings in the village, from the estate of the deceased Rev. D. Dyck, at an auction for 11,000 Rubel. We sowed wheat, rye, oats, barley, and also planted corn, potatoes cucumbers, watermelons and pumpkins on the farm. The children had to help on the farm when still young. Corn, potatoes, cucumbers, watermelons and pumpkins had to be hoed, while in harvest time we had to set up sheaves. After threshing time we had to help harvest the corn, potatoes, watermelons and pumpkins. In the winter we had to help clean the barn and feed the livestock.

When I was seven years of age I started to go to school which was located across the street from our residence. In the winter, when there was snow on the ground they shovelled a path across the street. However, if it was muddy, they spread straw across it, so we would not get our feet wet, as we wore slippers all year round.

I loved to go to school to study, and I was especially happy when the teacher sometimes read a story to us. Sometimes the teachers took the whole school on an outing. One time we made a trip to the island Chortitza. This island was in the Ungepr River. The only way to go to this island was by ferry which was something new to us. We spent the whole day sightseeing on the island.

After completing the sixth grade, we had to write examinations in order to enter High School. The first subject was arithmetic. I was always good in arithmetic, but now I could not solve the given problem. So I was excluded from the rest of the examinations and I had to go another year in the elementary school before I could enter high school.

The next spring we had to write the examinations in the village of Chortitza, twelve km. from our village. This time I passed the examinations with honour. I still have my reports of the examinations in German and in Russian. In the fall of the year 1916 I entered into the second grade of the Zentralschule or high school. My best subjects were: drawing, history, arithmetic and geometry.

While attending the third grade in April 1918, a band of bandits came into our village to rob and to steal. The leader of this band was a woman Marusja Nikiforowa. My brother John was on the way to the Dreizehnrodsche field to plow. He had four of our best horses harnessed to a wagon and was just leaving the village when he noticed the band coming from the other direction into the village. He turned his team around and rushed home and hid the team in the shed. Just then the bandits came into our yard, opened the door to the shed, saw the horses and took all four of them. They robbed and stole throughout the village. That was my last day of school.

As far as I can remember this was the first band of bandits that came to our village after the overthrow of the government (the Revolution of 1917). The Tsar had to renounce his throne and later he and his whole family were brutally killed in Yekaterinburg (Sverdlovsk).

Up to this time the villagers lived a peaceful life. They were free to practice their way of living without interference. They prospered, had their own schools and attended their church, which also featured a choir consisting of fifty-one members in 1923. They were thankful for the peace and tranquility that they were enjoying but which was soon to change. The outbreak of war between Russia and Germany in 1914 brought a great change to the peaceful life of the village. Young men as well as men up to the age of forty-two years were conscripted into the war effort, mostly into the medical corp, and to some extent in other parts of the service. Then in February 1917, when the revolution broke out, the economy of the villagers was severely effected.

In the spring of 1918 the German Army occupied the Ukraine including our village. The immediately dissolved the Soviets that were set up by the Bolsheviks. In Osterwicj they arrested the chairman of the Soviet, Shakalow, and his assistant, taking them to Chortitza, where Shakalov was sentenced to death and shot.

But the German Army did not stay long for in the fall of the same year they had to retreat. After the retreat of the German Army, the bandits were again roving the country. On a Sunday afternoon, in the fall of 1919, a band of bandits came into Osterwick to rob and to steal. When they left two of them remained. They rode into the yard to rob the people of their valuables. A German soldier who had remained as the German Army retreated, and a few young men from the village armed themselves and shot after the bandits. The bandits turned their horses up the field, south of Osterwick. One of them was hit and fell off his horse, but one foot was caught in the stirrup and he was left dragging along for a time. The other bandit stopped and freed his companion's foot, left him there and rode away. The German soldier ran up to the wounded man and shot him. Now the whole village was in uproar. They were afraid that the escaped bandit would come back with others to revenge themselves. So they called all the young men to come with their guns to the west end of the village. Because they expected the return of the bandits from this side. Only two young men appeared but no bandits came.

Soon after, on October 8, 1919 before daybreak another band of bandits came into our village. This time they came to kill. After it became lighter outside we saw two men on horseback driving a man ahead of them. This man was our neighbour, Jacob Klassen. They drove him on with their rifles up the hill, where the windmill was standing. Here they shot him and two other men Johann Dyck and Anton Funk. They gave orders to bury them the same day, and before the day was over two coffins were carried out toward the cemetery, with their relatives and friends following them. The third one was carried out the next day. That was a day we will always remember.

The bandit that shot our neighbour came to us and told us what he had done and asked the whereabouts of our father. We told him we did not know, and he said that father did not have to hide himself because he had done a good thing for them when their mother was ill. It was in threshing time when our father unhitched two

horses from the threshing machine and drove their mother to a doctor. They would never forget this favour that father had done.

The same month Osterwick was occupied by bandits (led by Nestor Machno). Machno was born in 1889 in South Russia. During the revolutionary period in 1905, Machno participated in the uprising. In 1908 he was captured and imprisoned for life. During the revolution of 1917 he was set free. He returned to his home town. Cruel, mean and hating all the rich, he gathered an army and marched through the villages, especially the Mennonite, plundering raping and murdering. They came to Osterwick in October and stayed til Christmas. In every home three or more bandits stayed.

The occupation of the Machnowze also brought to the village and surrounding colonies the typhoid epidemic. Many died of typhoid. In Osterwick alone one hundred and fifty people died in the winter of 1919-1920. My grandfather died Dec. 17, father Dec. 22, and mother December 24.

It was during the first part of December when a house searching Committee came into our house to search for hidden things. Nearly all of our family were ill with typhoid fever. My father did not feel well, so he sat on a bench near the oven. This committee asked father to sign a paper indicating that we did not have any hidden things and if they should find anything, they would shoot him. Because father was sick, I told them that I would sign the paper, but before I would sign it I would give them the harnesses we had hidden in the barn. The house and barn were built together. The barn was divided into three parts. In the first part we kept the livestock, in the second part were the farm implements, and in the third part we kept the chaff for the feed. In this part we had the harnesses hidden. I signed the paper and this signature almost costed me my life. I went with them into the barn where the harnesses were hidden and gave them to this committee. I told them that was all we had hidden. They did not believe me, and one of them hit me with his riding whip over the shoulder, barely missing my head. At that they left me but one, who took me into the fuelshed. By this time it was dark. We went into this shed and he closed the door behind us, lit a candle and placed it on a beam. I had to stand against the wall with my face towards it. He pulled out his revolver and put it against my neck and told me to reveal the hidden things or he would shoot me. He really meant what he said. I told him that we did not have anything hidden in that shed, and that was the truth. He pressed the trigger and I heard the click of the hammer but I heard no bang. I heard him step back. So I turned my head and I saw him examining his gun by the light. He turned the cartridge drum and came back. He threatened me again that he would shoot me if I would not reveal the things we had hidden in there. I stayed calm all the while and I told him repeatedly there was nothing hidden, so he finally released me. I know it was God who protected me. Soon after I also got sick and was on the verge of death. My brothers and sisters thought I was dying, so they called our preacher David H. Rempel, who lived across the street. But the Lord decided that I should live and I recovered. By this time the band was driven out by the Bolsheviks.

The typhoid epidemic lasted until the end of February 1920. Because so many died and others were ill, it was impossible to have funerals. Therefore they had a general funeral service in the spring in memory of all the people who died during the time of the typhoid epidemic. Rev. D.H. Rempel officiated with the text from Luke 20:28; 7:13.

During 1920 the Red Army was constantly involved in fighting with the White Army. The village's were required to provide transportation for the army supplies and soldiers. One fine summer day I had to hitch a team of horses to a wagon and drive, with others from our village, to Alexandrowsk, about 25 km. away. In Wosnesensk, a Russian village on the left bank of the Dnjepr River, we had to stay over night. There were a few of us from Osterwick and we stayed together. In the evening we picked some cherries from the cherry trees in the garden. We put the cherries into a pail with water and boiled them over an open fire so we had cherry compot for supper. It was delicious. The next day towards evening they released us. Afterwards we found out it was because the White Army with General Wrangel as leader, persuing them. When we arrived at the river it was evening and the were about to close the floating bridge. The bridge was made by anchoring large boots and fastening planks on top of them. The bridge by Einlage was partly blown up, therefore the Red Army had built a floating bridge.. At night they took a few boots out so that nobody could cross over. When we came to the river they were about to take some boots out and they did not want to let us cross. We begged them until they permitted us to cross , so we came to the village of Einlage and stayed over night. I drove unto one yard, unhitched the horses, fed them and laid down to sleep. In the morning I was awakened by loud noise. They were clearing away the bridge. They loaded the boots unto wagons with six horses pulling them. After the road was clear I continued my journey home.

Soon after I was called again to come to the Schulz factory. Here the field kitchen was stationed. I had to drive a few soldiers to Kronsweide, an abandoned village, to get get some firewood for the kitchen. We drove at night because we had to drive along the river and the White Army was stationed on the other side of the river. Arriving at our destination, we had to stay all day under cover because the enemy was bombarding this village all day. After dark we loaded the wagon with lumber torn from buildings and drove back to Osterwick, arriving there at midnight. I unharnessed the horses, fed them and went to sleep. Early the next morning I was again awakened by a loud noise. The Red Army was fleeing with the White Army behind. I quickly dressed myself and ran to the place where I had left my team, but the horses and wagon were gone. I started off on foot, but later got a ride. When we came to Tomakowka, a Russian village, I caught up with my team. They had stopped to feed the horses. When I arrived an enemy airplane flew overhead and the soldiers started vigorously firing at it with their rifles but without scoring a hit. At once we received order to hitch up and drive west. The road was full of vehicles, and I also steered my horses into the street and drove west at full speed. There were about six rows of vehicles and when we came to a bridge only two rows could cross. I was lucky to be able to go

over the bridge, the rest had to go through the valley, through the creek below and up on the other side. I do not know if all got through safely.. Once we were out of the village, we drove the horses on, they were running very fast, but we still forced them to go faster.

We passed a field of grain in stooks. Two men had loaded a wagon full of sheaves, when they saw the army fleeing, they panicked, one drove the horses and the other unloaded the grain. As far as the eye could see, in the rear and in the front, there were vehicles upon vehicles. Everybody was on his own without any privileges. There were officers on their "droshkys", horse-drawn cannons, military wagons and all types of farm wagons. Everybody was trying to go as fast as possible. If a wheel broke on a wagon they unhitched the horses and fled on horseback.

To lighten the wagons some were unloading things such as flour, sugar, potatoes etc. When we got to the next village the soldiers had to get off the wagons. It looked as if they were getting ready to fight, but the enemy did not come that far. By the time we arrived at the village, it was dark. We unharnessed the horses and fed them. We were also hungry as we had not eaten since the night before. We Osterwicker got a loaf of bread from the breadwagon and had our meal.

One day we were ordered to hitch up again and drive west to Nikopol. I remember that on the way we stopped in one village for the night. There were many apricot trees in the garden with ripe fruit on them. We drivers received only half the food ration, so we were always hungry. Therefore we went into the garden and ate apricots. At one time we received a small box of matches, which were very scarce. I went to a farmer to trade the matches for some food and he gave me a large piece of bacon in exchange. As we came to the suburb of Nikopol, we were ordered to return because the White Army drove the Reds back at this point. This time our destination was Yekaterinoslav (Dnjepopetrovsk seventy-five miles away. Here we stopped for a longer period. We had to sleep outside and the nights were cold. So we made a fire and laid down around it. In the morning we went to the peasants of the village and begged for food. By the time the Red Army drove the White Army back at Alexandrowsk, we had to retreat towards Tomakowka. West of Tomakowka we stopped again. Many of the drivers were released and went home. So I went to the commander of my detachment and asked to be released. I do not know the reason, but he did not let me go. I had been away from home for a whole months and was tired of travelling, so I told the soldiers to keep my team and I would walk home. I did not even wait for breakfast but started off early in the morning. It was about noon when I got very hungry. When I passed a windmill, I asked the owner for some food. The house was nearby, so he told me to come with him. We went into his house where the wife had just finished baking bread. She cut a large piece from one loaf and gave it to me. I thanked her for it and was on my way

again. It was evening when I got home, it was very good to be back again. In a month time they sent us the team, horses and wagon back again from Yekaterinslav.

By 1914 the village s of Osterwick were at peak of prosperity. But then came World War I, the Revolution, roving bandits and Machno which changed everything. In 1920 most of the land could not be worked because we had only a few horses and there was hardly any seed grain. Very little seed was sown and besides we did not get the needed rain, so there was a crop failure. Many died of starvation.

In 1920 the Mennonites of America sent a Commission to Constantinopel. From here they were supposed to try to get in contact with the Mennonites in the Ukraine. The men in this commission were O.O. Miller, Clayton Kratz and Artur Slagel. They arrived in Constantinopel Sep. 27, 1920. Slagel stayed in Constantinopel, Miller and Kratz drove to the Molotschna to get in contact with the Russian Mennonites. This meeting was in October 1920. Miller went back to get the provisions, Kratz stayed behind. In November of the same year Kratz disappeared. He was arrested by the Bolsheviks and was never heard from again. It was assumed that he had been killed.

In spring of 1921 American help came to Osterwick. They set up the so-called 'American Kitchen' in the yard of the Schulz factory. The needy received one meal a day consisting of soup, cocoa, rice, and a bun. This saved many from starvation.

The prophet said: "He will be very gracious unto thee at the voice of thy cry; when he shall hear it, he will answer thee. And though the Lord give you the bread of adversity." Isaiah 30:19-20. This is what we experienced in Russia. We thank God for making the American Mennonites willing to help us.

After this many decided to emigrate to a different country. They wanted to go to Canada. My brother John, his wife and I also decided to go. We were examined by a doctor and we were found to have an eye disease, trachoma. We visited the eye-doctor Dr. Gueckmann in Alexanderowsk, he healed our eyes and we were free to go. That was in 1923.

May 29, 1923 I was baptized upon my faith, in Osterwick, by Rev. P. Neufeld and accepted into the Mennonite Church of Osterwick.

In July we sold all our belongings at an auction. We did not get much for it, but it was sufficient to pay for the papers we needed to get to the border. The freight cars were at the station Kanzerowka, on July 29, 1923. We had to prepare these cars in order to live in them. On each end we built a platform about four feet from the floor, so that we could sleep on the floor and the rest on the platform. About six families were supposed to travel in one freight car. Monday, July 30, after saying farewell to our beloved ones we boarded the train and by six o'clock were on the way. Someone started the song: "God be with you till we meet again" and everybody joined in.

But would there be a time that we would meet again? For most of us not. From our family only my brother John with his wife and I emigrated. My sister Helen, who was married to Peter W. Janzen and my four younger brothers and sisters: Abram, David, Anna and Greta remained in Russia. Abram, Anna, Greta and Peter Janzen died in Russia and we never saw them again. Sister Helen and brother David came later to Canada. All people that remained in Russia had to go through many hardships. Most buildings that were vacated by the emigration were occupied immediately.

Several years passed and the villagers who had remained seemed to sense an upswing in the economy, partially due to the new economic policy adopted by the new revolutionary government. This upswing, however, did not last long enough to heal the wounds, left by the war, revolution and the Machnowtshina. The Soviets introduced the collective farm system and this resulted in extremely difficult times for the people. All farm work from then on was done collectively.

In the years that followed it became still more difficult and harder for the people because many were persecuted, thrown into prisons and later sent to slave labour camps in Siberia. Families were separated and their normal family ties were broken as part of the Soviet persecution.

For a time the villagers were relieved from persecution in 1941 when the German Army invaded Russia and had the Mennonite villages under occupation. When the German Army retreated from Russia, most of the villagers fled to Germany. There they obtained lodging and sustenance. At the end of the war in 1945, however, many were forcibly returned to Russia and the remainder emigrated to Canada and Paraguay. Many of the latter have since left Paraguay and have made Canada their home.

After reading the foregoing, one can see that our Osterwickers are now scattered all over the globe from their once so peaceful village. They are now to be found in northern Russia, down in the southern Russian border near Afghanistan; only a few are still in or near their original area in the Ukraine. Others are scattered elsewhere in the world: Germany, Paraguay, Argentina, Brazil, United States of America and Canada.

The villagers of Osterwick, along with others from the colony in the Ukraine have left a sad and sorrowful path behind them. Many died during these troubled years, were persecuted, murdered, and taken to slave labour camps. Many have never been heard from again and their final resting places are unknown. The forests of the Urals, if they could speak, would tell many a sad tale and they harbor many graves of friends and family.

This much has been written about the people that remained in Russia. I shall now return to the emigration period of my life. In eleven days we reached the Latvian border. Often they pushed our train unto a side track and left us there, sometimes for a whole day. These are the main cities we passed through: Alexandrowsk, Kharkow, Belgorod, Kursk, Orel, Brjansk, Smolensk, Vitebsk, and Sebesg close to the border. On August 10, we drove through

the Red Gate on the Latvian border. In Latvia we drove through Rezhitzia, Riga and on August 13, we came to Libau, the harbour on the shore of the Baltic Sea. It was 5:30 pm when we arrived here, and immediately we boarded the ship, Moskau. We sailed one day on the Baltic Sea. On the second day in the morning we sailed through the Kiel canal and then unto the North Sea. The North Sea was stormy and many were seasick. In the morning of August 17th we arrived in Hull, Great Britain. After we had breakfast, we boarded a train and drove through Britain, arriving at Liverpool at 6 o'clock. Here we boarded the oceanliner 'Montrose'. This was a beautiful ship. Immediately we sailed off unto the Atlantic Ocean. We spent a whole week on the ocean. It was a wonderful voyage. The food was good and I enjoyed the entire trip. August 24th we arrived in Quebec, Canada. Here we boarded a CPR train and on August 27, at 3:30 p.m. we arrived in Rosthern, Sask. Here at the station we were welcomed by Rev. David Toews. Many had come to take us into their homes. He sang several songs: "Lobe den Herren den mächtigen Koenig der Ehren" und "Nun danket alle Gott. I went with John Fieguts in a model T Ford. They lived on a farm in Tiefengrund. It was harvest time, so the next morning I had to set up sheaves. Fieguts were good to me. Here I worked until spring 1924. Most of the money I earned, I paid for my 'Reiseschuld'. From the Latvian border to Rosthern Sask., we came on credit by the C.P.R. In spring of 1924 I started to work for J. Funk on his farm. Here I got sick and came to my brother John, who in the meantime had bought a farm in Osler, Sask. I helped him with the harvest and threshing. After that I worked in different places. In 1926 I worked for O. Eby at Guernsey, Sask. Here I met Sara Klassen. We knew each other from Russia, but here we learned to know each other better. In the spring of 1927 we celebrated our engagement in my brother Johns house at Osler. On April 10, 1927 we were married in the Mennonite Church in Hague, Sask. Rev. D.H. Rempel performed the wedding ceremony. As text for our wedding he chose Jos. 24:15 and Ruth 1:16-17. D.H. Rempel was my previous teacher and minister in Osterwick, Russia. The wedding was on a Sunday. In the evening we took the train to Saskatoon. The next morning we went to Eatons and bought some of the things we needed for our household. This we shipped to Hepburn, Sask. Here we rented a house together with Frank Schellenberg, his wife being Sara's sister. That spring I worked for two month on a farm near Gladworth. Later we bought a house in Aberdeen, a place thirty miles from Hepburn. The cost of the house was \$300.00. Brother John helped us in the moving to our newlu acquired property. What a joy it was to move into our new home!

My wife Sara was born on the island of Chortitza. This island had been the headquarters of the Cossacks, one of the tribes of Southern Russia.

The first Mennonites settled here in 1789. There were and still are many tourist attractions on this island. There are rocks up to 130 feet high. The river itself is a wonderful sight, its stream is limpid, while all the other rivers are torbid and muddy. It contains an abundance of most delicious fish. Ships went along the river quite often. Some ships stopped at the village to pick up passengers and later to bring them back. In the lower

part of the island was a wooded area, which they used for grazing cattle. Close to the village was a forest of fir trees, very suitable for picnics. The whole island is 12 km. long and $2\frac{1}{2}$ miles wide and includes 3,000 Ha (7,500 acres) of land. The best watermelons were grown on this island and shipped by barges to other parts of the country. In 1916 this island was sold to the city of Alexandrowsk (Aporozje).

The villagers were allowed to stay on the island, but they had to rent the farms. Sara's parents were Gerhard Klassen and Aganetha nee Hildebrandt. Sara went to school on this island, her teacher was Peter Isaak. Her father died in 1916 and her mother in 1919. It was in this year that her brother Gerhard was murdered. At this time she with her brothers and sisters abandoned their home. They left most of their possessions on the island and fled to Chortitza to their relatives. From here they went to Burwalde. Later as her sister Anna got married to Peter Dyck, she and her sister Helen, and brothers Henry and Corny moved with P. Dycks to Kronstal, adjacent to Osterwick. Here she was baptized in the Osterwick church June 6, 1922 by Rev. Is. Dyck. From here she came to Canada in 1923. She worked at a few places in Guernsey until we got married.

As we moved to Aberdeen, we joined the Mennonite Church there. Soon after I was elected as Sunday School teacher. I have been teaching Sunday School ever since.

In 1933 Peter Koop and I were elected into the ministry by the Mennonite Church of Aberdeen, Sask. At that time the Church had no preacher, therefore we had to commence preaching right away. In 1938 we were ordained by Rev. David Toews.

Here in Aberdeen five children were born to us:

In spring of 1928 I started to work as sectionman for the Canadian National Railroad and worked for this company until 1947. In February 1947 I made a trip by train to B.C. where I bought 3.36 acres of land on Townline Road, Abbotsford, BC. for \$300.00 an acre. In June of the same year we sold our property in Aberdeen, Sask. and moved to B.C. We shipped the furniture by freight and went by car. We had a 1935 Dodge at the time. The last night in Saskatchewan we stayed with Corny Klassens on the farm. July 3, 1947 we started off for B.C. In the evening we crossed the border to Alberta. It was late as we turned off the road, close to a railway station, and tried to sleep in the car. We were six of us. Alvin had stayed in Saskatchewan as he had a good job working for O.K. Stores. On July 4, we drove through Coaldale, Lethbridge and MacLeod. From here we drove through Glacier National Park. We had to drive over high mountains. This road is open only a few months during the year. After crossing the mountains we stayed over night in the first motel we found.

It was still early, but we were tired and in no hurry. The next day we had trouble with the brakes. It was difficult to find a garage where men were working because it was Saturday. At last we found one, and it took them all afternoon to repair the brakes of the car. At five o'clock we were on our way again. We drove through Spokandip Washington a motel for the night. The next day - Sunday - what a beautiful day it was! The sun just started to rise and the roads were still empty. The wheat beside the road was beautiful. We drove on #10 Toad, through Wenatchee and Everett. At Sumas we crossed the border, drove through Abbotsford to Henry Classen's on Station Rd. It was berry picking time, so we picked berries and hops. Before picking hops we built a garage on our lot and moved into it. After the hop-picking season we started to build a house. On Christmas eve we moved into this house. It was not completed but we had a roof over our heads. Here we joined the West Abbotsford Church, I was accepted as minister. Here in B.C. I did carpentry work and built houses for other people. Besides we had some chickens, strawberries and raspberries.

In 1952 we celebrated our twenty-fifth wedding anniversary. In 1963 we joined the Ebenezer Mennonite Church on Windsor Road and I also was accepted as minister.

In 1969 we sold our property on Townline Road and built a house in Clearbrook at 2427 James Street. February 15, 1970 we moved into this house. In 1970, when I became 70 years old, I retired but have been preaching occasionally. I have also been helping in Sunday School and Bible Study on Wednesday night. I enjoyed the work for the Lord very much. "We can truly say: 'Hitherto hath the Lord helped us.' 1.Sam. 7:12

In 1930 they were sent to Biysk Altaysk to do the same work. 1931 they had to crush rocks for roadbuilding at Korosten, near the Polish border. They also had to work at the electric power dam.

1936 they built a house in Osterwick. In 1943, before the German occupation, David was exiled for 10 years of hard labour at Workuta; was released after nine years just to find out that his wife Aganetha had died of tuberculosis in Berlin, Germany. 
